PREPRATION SHEET FOR COCKROACHES TREATMENT

We have been contracted by the management of this building to provide a pesticide application to your suite for the elimination of **Cockroaches**.

NOTE: If you are unable to accommodate this appointment, please contact your resident manager immediately, or call us.

For our service technicians to Provide most effective treatment, we ask your co-operation in carrying out the following instructions:

- In <u>all rooms</u>: Move all furniture at least <u>2 feet</u> away from the walls so treatment can be applied to baseboard perimeters. Heavy wall units may remain and we will work around them. These items do not require covering over unless they contain dishes or food. Fridge and stove should be moved out as well.
- 2. Remove all items from lower and upper kitchen cupboards, drawers, counter tops, stove and fridge tops and place them on kitchen table and cover over with plastic film, blankets or sheets.
- 3. Linen, Broom and Clothing storage closet **floor** areas must be cleared of all items. These items can be placed on the beds.
- 4. Birds and pets must be removed from the premises, and fish tanks must be covered and the filter pump turned off, to prevent any possibility of poisoning.
- 5. Children's toys should be placed in plastic bags or covered toy boxes.
- 6. Unplug all cords from outlets, and cover TV's, computers, and other electronic items to prevent any spray from settling on them.
- 7. Most multi family dwellings are equipped with smoke detectors or similar devices. All of these sensors should be covered with plastic and secured with tape. The reason for covering these sensors is to prevent the fumigation process from setting them off. If

tenants are not capable of covering these devices, our technicians will perform the task for an additional charge.

Special Instruction In Kitchen Areas

- 1. Remove everything from cabinets and drawers.
- 2. Remove dishes individually and inspect each one for roaches that may be hiding.
- 3. Place contents of cabinets and drawers (but not the drawers themselves) on the dinning table or coffee table.
- 4. Discard any food that is opened.
- 5. Take the unopened food and place that on the dinning table or coffee table.

Special Instruction In Bathroom Areas

Remove all medicines, toothbrushes, personal care products and place them into plastic bags and close tightly. Remove the bags from the bathroom and place in a location where they will not impede access to bathroom. The bathtub is suggested for this.

NOTE: Upon re-entry to your premises do not wash any of the baseboards or cupboards for a period of at least six weeks. The pesticide has residual effects lessened by washing.

Cupboard shelves and drawers should **not** be washed before returning any items but must have non-adhesive paper on them before returning any items. Kitchen counter tops, cutting boards, fridge and stove tops should be washed prior to any items being returned to them. Vacuum after treatment especially along the baseboards, use crevice tool to get into corners and cracks. Regular vacuuming should be done because cleanliness and sanitation is a vital part of eradication and successful treatment.

Where pregnancies, allergies, illnesses or other unusual circumstances occur, occupants may wish to remain out of the premises for periods **longer** than those indicated above.
